#### Signs in the Neighborhood including Political Signs

Please remember that signs advertising contractors, school events, etc. are not allowed in Tamarron.

Political signs are exempt from this however, they can only be set out 30 days prior to an election and must be removed within 5 days after the election. We ask that everyone please comply with the sign policies.

#### **Exterior Light Fixtures**

There are quite a few homes in the neighborhood where the yard post light is not working. Each home in Tamarron is required to have at least one working wall bracket light fixture adjacent to the main entry door and one post light adjacent to the driveway sidewalk intersection. If you yard light is not working, please have it repaired.

#### Taking Fido for a Walk?

Please remember that dogs need to be on a leash when outside and it is the Owner's responsibility to clean up after its pet.

## Trash and Recycle Carts Power Washing

Two of our biggest issues in the neighborhood are trash cans sitting out where they can be seen and houses that need power washing. If your trash or recycling cans can been seen, please move them so they cannot be seen from the street or by an adjacent owner. Does your house need power washing? Please wash it! One courtesy letter will be sent to owners prior to fines being assessed for non-compliance with the rules of the neighborhood.

#### **Speed Limit in Tamarron**

We have a lot of walkers in Tamarron. The posted speed limit is 25 mph. Please be attentive when driving through the neighborhood and please obey the speed limit!!

# USE YARD WASTE CARTS OR PAPER BAGS FOR LEAF COLLECTION (FREE in NOVEMBER!)

If you want leaves taken off of your property, you can fill brown paper yard waste bags (available at grocery and hardware stores, plus other retailers) or a City of Bloomington yard waste cart and set them out at the curb on your regular yard waste collection day.

There will be no collection charge for bagged leaves or leaves placed in yard waste carts during the month of November (typically \$1 per collection of leaf bag or yard waste cart; collection fees will resume in December).

Brown paper leaf bags will again be made available to the public at no cost, beginning in October. Please check back here for more information.

If you are interested in purchasing a yard waste cart, please contact the Sanitation Division at (812) 349-3443. You can find your regular bi-weekly yard waste collection days by searching for your address in our <u>myBloomington</u> tool.

- Please do *not* compact your leaves so tightly into the carts that they become heavy and difficult to wheel to the curb.
- Remember: if it is too heavy for you to roll, it will be too heavy for us to roll!
- Residents will be charged a fee if their yard waste carts or paper bags are filled with anything other than dried leaves.
- The yard waste crew will not collect leaves in plastic bags.
